UPV/EHU explains that since the project is funded by the European Union, we have to comply with the rules and templates provided by the Erasmus+ programme.

Besides, UPV/EHU explains that we need to respect the compromises taken by UPV/EHU to get the project funded by the Spanish National Erasmus+ agency. Those compromises are detailed in the Guidelines. It is very important to keep documents and evidences of the participation of KPI in the present UPV/EHU's project.

KPI shows its interest and will to collaborate with UPV/EHU in this project.

KPI will check the content of the agreement and will fill in the missing information and send the agreement back to UPV/EHU.

Now UPV/EHU proposes KPI to sign an agreement for students valid until 2020-2021 academic year, in order to avoid being singing new agreements every year. Nevertheless, with its current 2015 Erasmus+ KA107 project, UPV/EHU has only grants for students and only coming to its Faculty of Engineering-Bilbao. Besides, in the framework of the project in force, student mobilities must take place between September 2016 and the end of January 2017 (starting the last week of August 2016 if the students come to the Spanish Intensive Course organized by the International Relations Office for two weeks).

The real use of the Erasmus+ agreement until 2020-2021 will depend on UPV/EHU keeping being beneficiary of future Erasmus+ KA107 projects in next years. Without Erasmus+ KA107 project in force for Ukraine, the Erasmus+ agreement cannot be used.

Every year UPV/EHU will inform KPI in the monitoring commission about the number of available grants for the following academic year. The mobilities of the Erasmus+ agreement will be used without grant only if both universities agree on it.

UPV/EHU informs KPI that with its current Erasmus+ project (awarded on November 2015), UPV/EHU can offer to KPI three grants: two grants for two undergraduate students and one grant for a master student coming from KPI to the Faculty of Engineering-Bilbao of UPV/EHU, during the 1st semester/fall semester of the academic year 2016-2017 (800 Euro/month up to five months and travel costs up to 360 euro).

UPV/EHU will send information about the regular procedure to nominate students before 2 May 2016^{1} .

Besides, UPV/EHU will send information about how to propose the names of the 3 Erasmus+ grantees. In order to become Erasmus+ grantees, the students must have been admitted first by the Faculty of Engineering as incoming students for 2016-2017 academic year. The two procedures will have to be respected separately, one after the other.
